EUREKA POLICE OFFICERS ARREST TWO AFTER LOCATING VEHICLE THAT WAS JUST STOLEN

On January 21, 2010, at about 7:14 AM, the Eureka Police Department received a report of a vehicle that was just stolen from the vicinity of West Clark and California Streets. The victim reported an unknown suspect took his white 2000 Dodge Durango after he left his keys in it. The suspect, who also left a bicycle behind, was last seen driving southbound on California Street from West Clark Street.

At approximately 7:29 AM, an observant EPD patrol officer spotted the victim's Durango stopped at the red light on Harrison at Harris Street. The suspect stopped in the 3300 block of Harrison Street, left the Durango, and walked to a nearby gray Jeep Cherokee, which he then entered.

The officer initiated a high risk stop on the occupants (3) of the Jeep Cherokee and waited for back-up to arrive. Upon the arrival of additional officers, the occupants of the Jeep were detained at gunpoint. The driver of the stolen Dodge Durango, Lance Andrew Borgner (age 20 of Eureka), was taken into custody for vehicle theft, possession of stolen property, and probation violation. A passenger in the Jeep Cherokee, Crystal Dawn Landry (age 24 of Eureka), was also taken into custody on a felony warrant alleging possession of methamphetamine for sale.
