A California Parolee with a nickname of “Lucky” was not all that lucky yesterday, 1-26-2001, as he was arrested with over an ounce of heroin, meth, drug paraphernalia and needles.

Craig James “Lucky” Hendley, 55, of Eureka was also charged with a parole hold.

POP (Problem Oriented Policing) officers had received information that the subject was selling drugs out of a motor home near a local trailer park. The officers were able to identify the subject and learned he was on parole so conducted a parole search and located the illegal items.

Since the heroin was all packaged in smaller quantities and he had a substantial sum of money on his person, he was charged with possession for sale.

Hendley was booked into the Humboldt County Jail on the following charges:

- Parole Hold
- Possession of controlled substance for sale (heroin)
- Possession of controlled substance (meth)
- Possession of drug paraphernalia
- Possession of hypodermic syringes/needles
