### **Subject: POP Search Warrant Nets Two Arrests**

On 1/04/11, at about 11:05 AM, officers with the Eureka Police Department's Problem Oriented Policing Unit (POP) served a search warrant on a mobile home in a trailer park on the 1200 block of Allard Ave., Eureka. The warrant was obtained after POP received information a resident was selling methamphetamine in the Eureka area.

Officers located and detained the primary suspect, Jeremiah William Ward (33 of Eureka) inside the mobile home. During a search of the residence, officers located a large quantity of drug packaging baggies, digital gram scales (for weighing out controlled substances for sale), methamphetamine pipes, hypodermic syringes, and a small quantity of crystal methamphetamine believed to be possessed/packaged for sale.

Jeremiah Ward also made admissions to officers about selling methamphetamine to earn a little extra cash. Jeremiah was arrested and transported to the Humboldt County Correctional Facility (HCCF) where he was booked for possession of methamphetamine for sale and possession of drug paraphernalia.

Additionally, Jeremiah's brother and housemate, Joshua Kurt Ward (31), was detained during an earlier related traffic stop on Harrison near Munson Street. Joshua was cited at the scene for being an unlicensed driver and later arrested and transported to HCCF for unlawful possession of hypodermic syringes.
