On 10/3/11 at approximately 7:45 pm, Officers of the Eureka Police Department were dispatched to the 2400 block of Manzanita St in an attempt to locate and apprehend a wanted parolee – Shiloh CHASE – who had been on the run from Law Enforcement for the past two weeks.

Officers arrived and conducted a search of a residence in the neighborhood without success.
