## Subject: Interrupted Burglary Update

On 12/10/14 at about 4:13 p.m., EPD officers responded to the 1600 block of 7<sup>th</sup> Street for a report of an interrupted burglary. The victim chased the suspect one block and detained him at the 1500 block of 7<sup>th</sup> Street. Chad Fraker 29 of Eureka was found to be in possession of the victim's property and was arrested for the burglary.

Later that evening, officers responded to the 1600 block of 7<sup>th</sup> Street for an additional burglary report to the residence across the street. The victim reported that the burglary happened sometime earlier that day. Evidence was collected at the scene that links Fraker to the burglary. Additionally, property taken during this burglary had been located amongst the property left behind by Fraker during his flight from the earlier reported burglary.

As of this afternoon, Fraker was still in custody at the Humboldt County Correctional Facility and a search warrant was served on his property. Detectives are currently attempting to obtain a bail enhancement for Fraker.

Most residential burglaries happen during the day while residents are away. Harden the target by locking all doors and windows. If you see something, say something. Notify your local authorities if you see suspicious behavior in your neighborhood.
