



NEWS RELEASE

On early Friday evening, 12-17-10, at about 4:30 PM, the manager of the “Tilt”, at the Bayshore Mall, reported he was a victim of a robbery. The manager was in the office when the assailant entered the office and demanded he open the safe. When he refused, the unarmed assailant attacked the manager. The manager eventually yielded to the suspect’s demands. The suspect escaped with an undisclosed amount of cash. (The amount of the loss will not be released to the public).

The victim manager suffered minor facial injuries and may have lost consciousness for a brief period of time. The victim manager was transported to the St Joseph Hospital emergency room and treated and released.

The suspect is described as a white male adult, mid thirties, about 6’ or taller, medium build, with long straggly blondish hair down to about the collar. The suspect wore a black ball cap, possibly with a “Raiders” logo, a gray hooded sweatshirt and blue jeans. The suspect had one unique characteristic, a noticeably lazy or drifting left eye.
