Subject: 3500 block of Spring Street Drug House Complaints result in 2nd Parole Search and 3 more Arrests

On 5/28/10, at about 3:58 PM, Officers with the Eureka Police Department's Problem Oriented Policing Unit (POP) conducted a second, follow-up parole search at a residence in the 3500 block of Spring Street. This was in response to complaints of continuing drug activity occurring in and around the apartment.

Officers found and subsequently arrested the following suspects inside for drug related offenses and outstanding warrants:

- Abel Resendes Vieira, 42 of Mckinleyville, was arrested after officers located 20 methadone pills (a Schedule II controlled prescription drug for which he did not have a prescription) and a usable quantity of crystal methamphetamine on his person. Vieira was transported to the Humboldt County Correctional Facility where he was booked for possession of a controlled substance.
- Teresa Ann Schieberl, 48 of Eureka, was arrested and transported to the Humboldt County Correctional Facility on an outstanding no bail warrant alleging possession of a controlled substance and probation violation.
- Resident Mary Margaret Oliva was cited and released for maintaining a place for purposes of drug use/sales, possession of drug paraphernalia, and unlawful possession of a hypodermic syringe after officers located drug sales paraphernalia (numerous drug packaging baggies, two scales and meth residue) and drug use paraphernalia (pipes, rubber tie-off, hypodermic needle) in her bedroom. Oliva was cited instead of taken to jail due to health considerations.
