Humboldt Bay Fire will be conducting hands-on firefighting and rescue training at the old Norman's Dry Cleaning building at 2911 E Street on February 27 and March 3 and 4 from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. each day. This training will be non-destructive and not involve any live fire. We will be practicing removing victims from smoke-filled buildings using theatrical smoke and window props. The building is planned to be demolished at some time in the future. Training in buildings in the community provides invaluable training to our firefighters and helps them be better prepared for response to emergencies.

Humboldt Bay Fire greatly appreciates the support of the community in permitting us to train in structures other than our training site. Apparatus will be parked off-street in the building's parking lot and every effort will be taken to minimize our impact on the neighborhood.
