

floor apartment while the truck crew ascended the aerial ladder to cut ventilation holes in the roof and check for fire extension. Subsequent arriving units shut off the utilities and assisted the occupant who had suffered smoke inhalation. The fire was quickly contained to the apartment of origin. No additional victims were located and the occupant was transported to St. Joseph's hospital for treatment.

HBF fire investigators determined the cause of the fire to be an unattended pot of food on the stove and the apartment sustained extensive fire damage to the kitchen and smoke damage to the remaining living areas.

Humboldt Bay Fire reminds everyone to never leave food unattended on the stove while cooking and to always have working smoke detectors in your residence.
