Dear Medi-Cal Beneficiary:

Due to budget cuts, as of April 1, 2011, Medi-Cal will not pay for drugs that have acetaminophen in them and you can buy without a prescription. (All drugs paid for by Medi-Cal still need a prescription from a doctor)

This will not affect people under 21 years of age. If adults try to get these drugs through Medi-Cal, the Medi-Cal Field offices will not approve it for payment. If you are denied the drugs and you disagree, you can ask for a fair hearing. You may ask for a fair hearing within 90 days of being denied by sending a letter to:
