On 11-05-2014, at approximately 10:45 p.m. a Humboldt County Sheriff's Deputy spoke with the driver of a purple colored SUV parked in a gravel turnout near the intersection of V Street and Pacheco Road, Arcata. The driver was contacted because the SUV was parked in front of a, "No Parking" sign. When the deputy spoke with the two occupants, an adult male and female, he could smell the strong odor of burning marijuana coming from inside the vehicle. The deputy asked the male occupant his name and he identified himself as Christopher Paul Littlejohn, 30 years old, from McKinleyville. A warrant check of Littlejohn revealed he had three felony and two misdemeanor warrants for his arrest. All the warrants were issued by Humboldt County Superior Court and were for drug related crimes. The deputy arrested Littlejohn on the arrest warrants. The deputy searched a backpack that Littlejohn had in his possession. Inside the backpack the deputy located 1.4 grams of suspected methamphetamine, three grams of hash, approximately 60 grams of dried marijuana and a wooden club (Billy).

Littlejohn was arrested for possession of illicit drugs, drug paraphernalia, possession of over one ounce of marijuana and possession of an illegal weapon. He was transported to the Humboldt County Correctional Facility where he was booked on the charges. His bail was set at \$135,000.00.

The female was interviewed and released at the scene.
