Subject: Methamphetamine Arrest Cases: 200908264

Humboldt County Sheriff's Deputies arrested a Eureka man yesterday after finding him in possession of 13 grams of suspected methamphetamine. Shortly after 1:00 p.m. deputies received information that a man wanted by the Eureka Police Department, Zachary Scott Stiglich, 29, was at a residence on the 2000 block of Holly Street in Eureka. Sheriff's Deputies arrived and contacted Judson Allen Stiglich, 27 (Zachary's brother), who denied Zachary was at the apartment. The deputies warned Judson that he could be arrested for obstructing a peace officer if Zachary was found inside the residence. Another resident at the apartment gave consent to the deputies to enter the residence and look for Zachary, whom they found hiding in a closet. After arresting Zachary, deputies arrested Judson for obstructing/delaying a peace officer. In Judson's belongings, deputies found 13 grams of suspected methamphetamine, several plastic baggies, ten narcotic pills, and seven grams of marijuana.

Both men were transported to the Humboldt County Correctional Facility. Judson was booked for possession of a controlled substance for sale, possession of a narcotic controlled substance for sale, possession of marijuana, obstructing a peace officer, and possession of drug paraphernalia. His bail was set at \$25,000. Zachary was booked for violation of a court order and vandalism. His bail was set at \$10,000. Both men are expected to be arraigned by Friday.
