Subject: Methamphetamine/Firearms Arrest

Humboldt County Sheriff's Deputies arrested a Eureka man early yesterday morning after finding him in possession more than six grams of methamphetamine, five rifles and a handgun. At about 2:30 a.m. a deputy was on patrol and saw a car parked (with its lights and engine off) at the McKinleyville Vista Point. There is a posted sign advising no overnight camping. The deputy contacted the driver, Kevin Grundman, 38, who spontaneously told the deputy there were guns in the car. A second deputy arrived to assist and Grundman was asked to step from the vehicle. Deputies found the firearms, methamphetamine, and a small amount of marijuana inside the car. One of the rifles had been reported stolen. Deputies arrested Grundman and transported him to the Humboldt County Correctional Facility. He was booked for possession of a controlled substance, possession of stolen property, and possession of marijuana. He posted bail in the amount of \$20,000 and is scheduled to appear in court on February 16, 2010.
