On May 17, 2012 at approximately 7:45 a.m., employees at the Humboldt County Sheriff's Office Animal Shelter arrived at the facility and found a dog chained to a tree on the east side of the facility. The dog was very fearful and would not allow the staff to approach him. An Animal Control Officer arrived at the shelter a short time later and was eventually able to leash the dog and free it from the chain.

The dog is a 3 year old male Border Collie. He was wearing a blue nylon collar. He appears to be in good health and well cared for.

At this time the Sheriff's Office is treating this as a case of Animal Abandonment, which is a misdemeanor crime. The shelter has video surveillance cameras and is currently in the process of examining the video footage to assist in the identification of the suspect(s).
