## FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE

On 07-23-2011, approximately 4:00 a.m. Humboldt County Sheriff's Deputies were dispatched to the 4000 block of Walnut Drive, Cutten for a possible residential burglary in progress. Deputies located two suspects in the immediate area on bicycles. One of the bicyclists attempted to flee resulting in two deputies pursuing him. One of the pursing deputies was able to pull the suspect off his bicycle. The suspect, identified as Christopher Henson 24 years old, of Carlotta was detained on Dolbeer Street. Deputies made contact with the victim and determined a residential burglary had occurred, and Henson was in possession of items belonging to the victim. Henson was also carrying a 12" fixed blade knife concealed down his pants along with a hammer.

Christopher Henson was arrested for obstructing or delaying the deputies, possession of a concealed weapon, burglary and possession of stolen property. Henson was booked into the Humboldt County Correctional Facility and is still currently there. His bail is set at \$75,000.00.

The other suspect was identified as a 16-year-old male juvenile. The juvenile suspect was turned over to a responsible adult, and charges against the juvenile for burglary are being requested through the District Attorneys Office.
