*BLUE LAKE* – Humboldt County Sheriff's Deputies arrested a 26-year-old Eureka woman yesterday morning after she was found to be in possession of methamphetamine, heroin, and marijuana. At about 5:00 a.m. deputies were called to the Blue Lake Casino when security personnel there found methamphetamine in Shena Christensen's purse. They reported that Christensen had left her purse in a restroom inside the casino. A staff member there found the purse and turned it in to security. Security staff looked inside the purse in an attempt to locate the owner. A short time later Christensen inquired about her lost purse. She was detained by security staff until deputies arrived. Deputies confirmed there was methamphetamine and a pipe in her purse and deputies placed her under arrest. Upon calling a tow truck for her vehicle, deputies conducted an inventory check of her car. Inside they found a small amount of tar heroin, more than one pound of processed marijuana, a digital scale, and trimming tools.

Christensen was transported to the Humboldt County Correctional Facility where she was booked for possession of a controlled substance, possession of a narcotic controlled substance, possession of marijuana (more than an ounce), the transport/sales of a controlled substance, and possession of controlled substance paraphernalia. Her bail was set at \$25,000.
