Dear Parents of Leadership and Athletic Students:





Having the pool out of commission until the correct screen and anti-siphon valve is passed by federal regulations is greatly impacting the business of Bodyworks.

Therefore, Bodyworks is planning to be closed as of December 30, 2008.
