**‘Love In Any Language’ to Benefit Scotia Union School District**

Scotia, CA--With California’s budget cuts, Scotia Union School district’s GATE and Leadership students are sponsoring a fundraiser on May 15<sup>th</sup>, to support their music and art program. As the budget cuts threaten several educational programs, the students hope to raise \$25,000 from the local community to ensure music and art continue.

The event includes a buffet-style dinner catered by CC Market, a live and silent auction with auctioneer Rex Bohn, and a live performance of multicultural dancers and singing.

Beginning at 5:30 p.m., there will be an auction preview with the dinner to follow at 6:00 p.m. The live auction will commence at 6:30 p.m. and the performance will begin at 7:00 p.m.. The show will open with students singing the “Love In Any Language” song, dressed in costumes from around the world. Also featured will be local multicultural dancers, including Hmong, Middle Eastern, Mexican Folkloricos, Hawaiian/Polynesian/Palauan and American Break Dance performers.

“We have such a multi-faceted community here in Humboldt now, and their talent reflects the diversity we are celebrating,” says Janelle Lampp, Scotia Principal and director of the event.

“I am more than a little excited and pleased to be able to offer our student this opportunity, not only to learn more about various cultures, but to allow them the pride and responsibility of helping to raise the needed funds for their studies. While the budget cuts are a bit of a black cloud, we are deciding to create a silver lining so to speak”, said Lampp.

“Love In Any Language” will take place at the Winema Theater in Scotia from 6:00 – 8:00 p.m. Tickets are \$20/adult, \$5/child for dinner and show, or \$10/adult, \$5/child for the 7:00 p.m. show only.
