Further transparency problems, in violation of campaign finance law

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TL;DR: Karen Paz Dominguez is still in violation of campaign finance law, she has not fully reported contributions and expenditures from the 2018 campaign, and there is an open FPPC investigation.

The Humboldt County Office of Elections originally filed a complaint to the Fair Political Practices Commission (FPPC) about this issue: https://www.fppc.ca.gov/enforcement/complaint-and-case-information-portal.html

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Some background, courtesy of the FPPC: Campaign finance laws are fundamental to fostering the public's trust and confidence in government. Campaign finance reporting, required by law and enforced by the FPPC, provides transparency, fairness, and integrity to the political system. The Political Reform Act, passed in 1974 in the aftermath of Watergate, requires candidates and committees to file campaign statements by specified deadlines disclosing contributions received and expenditures made. It is the responsibility of candidates and committees to understand the rules regulating their campaigns in California. Government Code §84200 provides for the requirements to file pre-election and semi-annual statements. Government Code §83113 directs the FPPC to prescribe forms for reports and statements, and to publish manuals and instructions for bookkeeping and preservation of records.

I have attached redacted copies of the relevant 2018 campaign finance forms, which are all publicly available by requesting them through the County Elections office. I have also attached my email from the elections office, dated 04/08/22, providing every campaign finance form submitted by Ms. Paz Dominguez's 2018 and 2022 campaigns. On 06/06/22 I confirmed again with the elections office that no additional or amended forms have been filed for the 2018 election (other than a Form 410 changing the committee name) and the missing information has not been included on any filings for the 2022 election.

Campaigns are required to file periodic reports by certain due dates, which cover specified reporting periods, disclosing contributions and expenditures during those reporting periods.

Ms. Paz Dominguez filed a Form 460 for the time period ending 05/19/18, but never filed a Form 460 for the time period covering 05/20/18 - 06/30/18. Although Ms. Paz Dominguez has stated multiple times that she fully reported her campaign's finances up to Election Day and only failed to submit termination paperwork after the election (representing the failure as a minor technicality), that is very clearly and undisputedly not true.

There is no documented attestation covering the time period of 05/20/18 – 06/05/18 (Election Day), and an outstanding \$3,593.29 loan due on 06/30/18 either became a contribution or it was repaid. The County elections office agrees – there is no complete record of contributions or expenditures for that time period, there is no record of the disposition of the loan, and the loan presents some important questions that require investigation (see below). Even if Ms. Paz Dominguez maintains that no contributions or expenditures occurred after 05/19/18 (this doesn't resolve the loan issue), attestation to those facts is mandatory. Simply put, she needs to put that in writing and sign her name to it, and dodging that responsibility is unacceptable. If Ms. Paz Dominguez provides false information on a campaign finance form and investigators find evidence, there are consequences. The public has a right to know the facts as the candidate attests to them under penalty of those potential consequences, not the loose, vague, and inaccurate statements Ms. Paz Dominguez has made to the media.

Some context and confusing details about what *has been reported* – The last Form 460 on file covers the period ending 05/19/18, but the form mistakenly reports a \$1,000 (cumulative \$1,500) contribution from the Humboldt & Del Norte Central Labor Council received on 05/25/18. In addition, there is a Form 497 on file documenting a \$1,000 contribution from AFSCME on 05/25/18. Form 497 is required to be filed within 24 hours of receiving a contribution totaling \$1,000 or more from a single source. Both forms are date stamped 05/29/18 by the Office of Elections, so those large contributions were reported late, but at least they were reported. I will leave it to the reader to identify the problems with an Auditor-Controller who struggles with filing forms accurately and on-time.

It is important to note that the existence of the Form 497 does not mean that no other contributions were received before 05/29/18, because contributions under \$1,000 would have been captured on the semi-annual Form 460, which covers the period of 05/20/18 - 06/30/18, and this form was never submitted. There are no other documents covering the time period up to Election Day (06/05/18), and there is no documentation of or attestation about expenditures made after 05/19/18.

While writing this I discovered a new problem related to the 2022 election: On 04/28/22 Ms. Paz Dominguez filed Form 460 and reported a \$1,144 non-monetary contribution from Dan Kelley, made on 04/07/22. The FPPC filing schedule requires that the recipient of a non-monetary contribution of \$1,000 or more in the aggregate must file a Form 497 within 48 hours from the time the contribution is received. There is no record of Ms. Paz Dominguez ever filing a Form 497 in 2022. The candidate is already in violation of campaign finance law again for this election cycle.

Another item of concern is that the disposition of a \$3,593.29 loan, incurred on 05/09/18, was never reported. The last Form 460 on file reports that the outstanding balance of the loan was due on 06/30/18. If the loan was not repaid it constitutes a contribution, and the amount is above the legal contribution limit. The lender, Fernando Paz, is Ms. Paz Dominguez's husband and the rules can be unique in that situation. It may count as a contribution from the candidate if it came from a shared account, but it may count as a normal contribution if it came from a separate account. If the former is true, the reader may wonder why the loan wasn't reported as coming from the candidate herself. Indeed, in a 2022 Form 460 Ms. Paz Dominguez reported separate loans from herself and Mr. Paz. The facts should be investigated to ensure a violation did not occur, and that is the FPPC's purview, but regardless of the potential violation the disposition of the loan definitely must be reported. As the County Elections office brought to my attention, if the loan was repaid, the public has a right to know where the money came from to make that payment.

Ms. Paz Dominguez appears intent on moving forward without ever filing a report for contributions and expenditures after 05/19/18 (excluding the large contributions required to be reported on Form 497), and without ever reporting the disposition of the \$3,593.29 loan. She has told KRCR and Lost Coast Outpost that the only form she failed to file was one terminating her campaign committee, that she ceased all campaign activity on Election Day 2018, and (implied) that all contributions and expenditures leading up to Election Day 2018 (06/05/18) were reported. Ms. Paz Dominguez has likely made or will make the same statements to the FPPC, and they are not true. Without filing the semi-annual Form 460, covering the period of 05/20/18 – 06/30/18, there is not a complete record of contributions and expenditures leading up to Election Day. The disposition of the loan has not been reported and this may have become a contribution if it was not repaid. Finally, Ms. Paz Dominguez likely did not cease all campaign activity on Election Day, according to statements she has made in response to allegations that she was using her Facebook campaign page for official communications from the Auditor-Controller. (https://lostcoastoutpost.com/2022/apr/20/pazdominguez-deleting-comments-and-banning-people/)

There is an interesting conversation to be had about where the Facebook campaign page blurred the lines between official communications and campaign communications, and I believe those communications must fall into one of those two categories, but that conversation is not the topic of this post. This fact cannot be contested – there is a period of time prior to Election Day 2018 where Ms. Paz Dominguez has never submitted a complete report of contributions and expenditures, and the disposition of the \$3,593.29 loan has never been reported. If that loan was not repaid by the 06/30/18 due date, and it became a contribution potentially above the legal limit, the public has a right to know this information.

Ms. Paz Dominguez is running for re-election and recently filed forms covering the time period of 01/0/122 - 05/21/22. Her filings do not make any effort to reconcile or otherwise report the previously unreported information for 05/20/18 - 06/30/18.

After it has been brought to the candidate's attention multiple times, and she has responded with dishonest answers and has still not complied with the law, I do not know what her motivation is or what she may be hiding. The law is clear and the problem is easy to resolve, and yet it has not been. My sincere hope is that Ms. Paz Dominguez completes these mandatory reports as soon as possible, so that the public may finally receive the transparency required under the law.
