NEWS RELEASE

On 9-20-2012, an officer with the Eureka Police Department met with the victim of a vehicle theft. A report was taken regarding the victim's Toyota pick-up.

At about 0745 hours, the Eureka Police Department dispatch center received a call from the victim regarding her vehicle. The victim had located the vehicle parked at the 10 block of W. Dollison Street and saw that three suspects were in the vehicle.

Officers responded to the scene and attempted to contact the subjects. One subject fled, while the other two were detained at gunpoint until additional officers could respond. Once additional units arrived on scene the two subjects were detained. They were identified as Frederick William Scott (39 years old) and Jeffrey Omar Aguilar (24 years old).

Officers began searching the area for the third subject, who was located a short distance away from the scene and once again fled from officers. A short foot pursuit took place and the subject was apprehended in 20/30 park with the assistance of a K-9. This third subject was identified as Tyrel Gerrad Brannon (21 years old).

A search of the immediate area where the suspects were contacted led to the discovery of stolen property from the vehicle and a shotgun.

The vehicle was processed and soon released to the victim at the scene. The suspects were taken to the Eureka Police Department to be interviewed.

All three subjects were booked into the Humboldt County Correctional Facility on a charge of possession of stolen property. All three subjects are on active parole and are not eligible for bail due to their parole status. Additional charges regarding the firearm may be added pending evidence processing results.
